# Purpose of Puckshooters Hockey School

It is the intention of **Braxfield Pty Ltd and Puckshooter Hockey School** to provide a positive and supportive community environment in which all members and their family can enjoy ice sports, improve skill levels and interact socially. As such, the financial burdens of **Braxfield Pty Ltd** are structured so as to ensure that the burden is evenly and equitably distributed across its **Braxfield Pty Ltd** membership.

## **1. Mission of Puckshooter Hockey School for Ice Hockey**

Our mission is to provide the best possible opportunity for any athlete to learn the foundations of ice hockey skills eg: skating, training, knowledge of the game, plays, on ice, off ice practice and the disciplines required by any player to achieve their goal.

## **2. Length of training**

Training and Development is offered in a 6 sessions of 1.5 hour block at Acacia Ridge Ice World. The first training session begins on **Monday June 13<sup>th</sup> 9.15pm sharp**. Please arrive in time to begin training on the ice at this time.

## **3. Costs for Hockey School and Membership**

Cost is **\$330 / 6 sessions**, plus **\$48** yearly insurance fee (see insurance section).  
or **\$ 65 / 1 session** ( if you can not make the whole block of 6 sessions )

## **4. Payment Policy**

Each participant will be invoiced for the 4 weeks including \$48 insurance cost (unless you are a continuing member and already have insurance). You are liable for the cost whether you attend or not and any costs to recover this money from you will be charged to you. The acceptable payment arrangements are direct deposit, credit card or cash payment in full prior to course starting. After that no monies will be taken on the training day. Direct debit can be arranged with fees being charged to you.

## **5. Family Policy**

Family members: Must be living under same roof, for siblings only.  
The second family member will automatically receive a 5% discount off the weekly fees, not insurance fee.  
The Third family member will automatically receive a 15% discount off the weekly fees, not insurance fee.

***Credit Card Facilities shall be available for your convenience see front page.***

NOTE: A participant shall not be financial if payments are not made on or by the due dates and you will NOT be allowed on the ice until the fees are paid.

Please also note that all payments must be recorded by the issuing of a receipt. Payments can be made at the Armoursmith Ice Hockey shop at 1/839 Boundary Road, Coopers Plains, deposits into the bank account either in person or via the internet or by credit card authorisation.

Do not bring money to the rink each week as this takes time that you and your coaches could be on the ice. You will need to deposit it or authorise credit card payments. **PAYMENTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED ON A WEEKLY BASIS.**

## 6. Equipment requirements

A full set of Hockey Certified Equipment will be required. Equipment may be purchased from a number of places. Armoursmith Super Store at 1/839 Boundary Road, Coopers Plains is our sponsor, you can view many items online at [www.armoursmith.com.au](http://www.armoursmith.com.au) and they will deliver items to the rink on Sundays or pick up at the shop.

Introductory Starter Kits are available at the Store.

Youth Kits (under 10) start at \$399.00

Junior & Senior kits start at \$699.00

You will be required to buy or hire (from the rink) skates and required to have an approved ice hockey stick. Armoursmith Store will send hockey equipment to the rink each Sunday that you have ordered for you to collect if this is more convenient.

- Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility especially when dealing with persons under 18 years of age, as your words and actions are an example.
- Be aware of, and maintain an uncompromising adherence to AIS standards, Constitution, By-Laws and policies.
- Operate within the rules of Australian Ice Sports
- Understand your responsibility if you breach, or are aware of any breaches of this Code of Conduct & Ethics.
- Do not use your involvement with AIS or a Member Association to promote your own beliefs, behaviours or practices where these are inconsistent with those of AIS and the Member Associations.
- Avoid unaccompanied and unobserved activities with persons under 18 years of age, wherever possible.
- Refrain from any form of verbal or physical abuse towards others.
- Refrain from any form of harassment towards, or discrimination of, others.
- Provide a safe environment for the conduct of the activity.
- Show concern and caution towards others who may be sick or injured.
- Be a positive role model.

## 8. Insurance

Rules & Regulations: Player Insurance

Puckshooters has a Sports Cover Insurance policy that covers the following categories:

- Sports Injury
- Coaches and off ice officials
- Public Liability
- Professional Indemnity

All insurance coverage for Puckshooters is managed by our Broker, MIB Insurance Brokers. This Insurance policy is available to all Puckshooter Members who subscribe to it. Under Australian Law, this insurance does not cover items covered by Medicare.

The insurance does cover non-Medicare items such as physiotherapy and dental where referred by a doctor. Should an injury to you occur, your first coverage is through Medicare, then any private health insurance policy you hold before this policy comes into effect. As a result, members are strongly urged to take out private health insurance cover.

Non-Australian residents (import players) are not covered by Medicare and therefore are required to take out their own health insurance.
